 - The type of documents that were accessible today in ENOVIA PLM:
 - Drawing
 - Datasheet
 - PPAP
 - SQP

... will be accessible in the new Windchill PLM system.

• We also have the possibility to submit RFQ and receive quotes within Windchill, but this feature will not be used immediately.



System Access

The access to Windchill PLM is slightly different from what we have today

- There is a new Veoneer Partner Portal (VPP) website where you could find the 4 different applications that were previously accessible from VPP:
 - Engineering Data (Windchill)


- Supplier Profile

- Veoneer Supplier Manual

- Web EDI
- We have implemented Single Sign-On (SSO) for Supplier Users to access their Engineering Data & Supplier Profile.
 - Once you've completed the initial setup, you won't need a password anymore, just your email address as login.
 - Veoneer Supplier Manual is now in Free-Access for everyone.
 - Web EDI still requires specific credentials.
- To further enhance security, we are introducing Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA).
 - This additional layer of security will help protect your account and ensure that only authorized users can access the system.

New Veoneer Partner Portal



Limited Number of Users

- By default, they are 3 licenses per supplier ID.
 - Would you need more accounts, please reach out to your Lead Buyer
 - Company size/set-up/constrains will be considered to eventually set-up additional users.
- Veoneer Team already identified several Supplier Users for each supplier.
 - 1. Supplier Users will receive an invitation by end of April from invites@microsoft.com
 - This 1st step is required to set-up your profile in our Access Management System.
 - You can then define your preferred authentication method (phone, ...) for MFA.
 - If you need urgently an account and you have not received any invitation by April 30th, check you SPAM folder (!) and then contact your Lead Buyer.
 - Even if their account is ready in the Access Management Systems, Supplier Users won't have any access to Data in Windchill PLM prior Go-Live.
 - 2. Supplier Users will receive a 2nd e-mail from Veoneer IT Service Desk veoneer@service-now.com
 - To inform Supplier Users that Access to Windchill PLM is granted.
 - Then to access PLM, go to the VPP: https://partner-portal.veoneer.biz
 - Click Access button in the Windchill/Engineering Data area (after Go-Live)

Make sure you have accepted the invitation send by <u>invites@microsoft.com</u> You should have already received an e-mail on behalf of Veoneer with the Domain name Veoneer.ommicrosoft.com (please check your spam folder).

This step is needed to set-up the Single-Sign-On (SSO) and Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) Processes It must be done only once, at your very first connection. Then you will not need any password but just your email as ID.

Go to the Vecneer Partner Portal (VPP) following the link: https://partner-portal.veoneer.biz In the Engineering Data area, you could find Help and Training Documents as well as Site Usage Requirements.

Click on the [Access] button, in the Windchill / Engineering Data area.



- Windchill PLM Go-Live for Veoneer & Suppliers
- Supplier Users can now access Windchill PLM
- Go to new VPP
